New Community Navigation Program

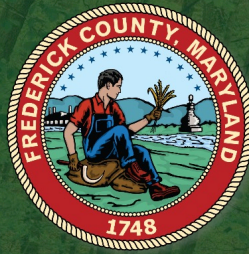
